The attendees discussed the issues of ethnicity vs. race and how we collect his data for reflectiveness. It was suggested that we look at the HRSA reporting requirements and follow those. This is a question for the project officer and will be asked on the next PO call. We also talked about the risk category percentages and how we classify these.
