(5.0) New Business/Old Business

Review the Strategic Planning and Assessment Planning Council Activity Timeline
 The Committee reviewed the Planning Council Activity Timeline and determined that everything was on track.

Review implementation of Health Care Reform/National HIV/AIDS Strategy and its impact on RW

Jeff presented the data request from the CT Department of Public Health regarding the HIV Care Continuum and New HIV cases by sex, race, age group and risk. He also mentioned that 1% of our clients are uninsurable and therefore this shows the importance of funding in MCM as a service category since there are no other funding sources for this service and EIS as well. A question was asked, "Are there people who are uninsurable who are not in our

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system for a variety of reasons and should there be a different type of outreach for these individuals? ". The data is showing that 30% of HIV+ people in CT are out of care and this was discussed. Is the number accurate? How can we reach out to them? Heidi has (6) new DIS employees that she is going to bring to the Planning Council meeting next week and their roles will be explained.

The committee also discussed the MCM Health Insurance Coverage Survey and ways to improve upon it:

- 1. Simplify the survey
- 2. Consistency within regions on how they are administering this survey.
- 3. Unduplicated client count we discussed how to come to this number. Could we take the MCM unduplicated count from the Resource Allocation Spreadsheet? Or, could Arvil run a report from CAREWare for Unduplicated Client Count by Region and then pass that number along to each region. They could also receive a client list as well referencing their client number.
- 4. Total number on the ACA not necessary to capture individual plans.

Review Framework of PSRA

- a. We discussed the feedback from the Special Planning Council meeting for PSRA. Overall feedback was very good. Jeff presented the approved Priority Settings and also the approved Resource Allocations. He also reviewed all the funding that was approved and the total ask for GY 2017.
- b. We also discussed that there is not a Federal Poverty Level for Medical Case Management and that HRSA lets local jurisdictions set their own. The question was asked as to why the CT DPH set the FPL is 300%? Should we align with CADAP at 400%? Also, is the FPL set the same for all services or can you pick and choose?
- c. Since Medicaid pays for mental health and substance abuse services, can we find out how many clients receive these services? This may be helpful when identifying what services to fund more.
- d. A comment was made that it makes sense to focus on the AOMC funding sources as well and reduce the percentage of funding that this service receives since it has other strong funding sources other than Ryan White.
- e. It was also said that we should apply for a core medical waiver (75% vs 25%) if we are seriously considering reducing the allocation percentage for AOMC.
- f. How many clients who were eligible for the ACA who are not enrolled?
- g. A questions was asked: in 2015 there were 803 clients in AOMC, how come we are paying for this? Why is there no other funding available for these clients? It was explained that a percentage of the staff salaries for this service is paid for by Ryan White funding.
- h. We may need a long term plan and short term plan to consider all of these questions and concerns. We also may need technical assistance from HRSA for input into this.
- i. FQHC vs. non FQHC was discussed as well. How much does Medicaid pay for these different types of providers?
- j. Is there a way we can look at the undocumented client by region number?

Charlotte Teel reported that DSS has been able to break down their information by region for us but is still working on grouping expenditures by service category. Charlotte will send what she has at this point to staff. 4/7/2016. We reviewed the data that Charlotte had on 5/6/2016. Staff reviewed this data again at the June meeting and it was decided that Charlotte will clarify that the towns listed under each region is where the client lives or where providers are located. Revisit Health Insurance Premium & Cost Sharing Assistance Service Category	In process – Letter sent to DPH regarding CIPA issues on 10/2 and a response was received on 10/22 and will be presented at the 11/6 SPA meeting. Staff will send a letter to the Commissioner of DSS with a CC to DPH regarding the outstanding issues by November 12, 2015. We sent this letter to DSS on November 19th and are waiting on a response. No response received from DSS. Staff sent a follow up letter to DSS and a CC to DPH Acting Director Dr. Pino on 1/27. A response was received on March 1 st from Commissioner Bremby from DSS. A contact name and number was included in the letter for any providers having issues with CIPA. This was sent out to all region leads by staff. Also-we need to look at what happens when Ryan White dollars are used for insurance premiums and the clients are receiving refund checks for these premiums, what happens to those refunds and what is the MCMs responsibilities. On 4/7/16 the committee reviewed the Health Insurance Cost Sharing Assistance Service Category Definition and discussed the client refund process regarding health insurance as it relates to the service category definition. There were 3 data requests were made at the 4/7 SPA meeting to be followed up in May. We discussed this on 5/6 and more information was requested by regions to identify where the total funding for this category is going. This information will be reviewed in June. This is closed now since the service standard was updated to address this issue.
