Roberta received a notice from HRSA regarding a clarification notice regarding the benefits offered to the staff/clients if 'abortion' is included in their healthcare benefits. Tom went onto clarify:



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- 1. You cannot offer insurance benefits funded by the federal government to clients whose benefits include abortion
- 2. You cannot use Ryan White Funds to cover staff if their plans include abortion.
